In the past few years, the Greek island Ikaria has become a stomping ground for journalists and scientists, all attempting to solve the mystery of the long lifespan of the residents - many of whom make it to over 100 years old! This longevity has been put down to what has become known as the Mediterranean Diet, which has been linked to lowering the rates of cancer, obesity and more recently heart disease. Of course what makes this even more of a persuasive diet to follow is that it is delicious!

Café Nion, the most recent gastronomic addition to the burgeoning Arundel Village Shopping Centre, is a nirvana for people following the Greek Mediterranean diet - and for those who just want some delicious, well-priced food.

Whether it is traditional dolmades, (stuffed grape vine leaves), souvlaki, (small marinated tender pieces of meat on a skewer), spanakopita (spinach enveloped in a filo pastry pie), tzatziki (a velvety dip made out of strained yoghurt, cucumber and garlic) or something from the pastry counter; kourabiedes (light almond shortbread), melomakarona (cookies with honey and walnuts)

or baklava (a rich pastry made with layers of filo filled with nuts and honey), Café Nion delivers the perfect spread.

The café is run by Zimbabweans of Greek origin, a mother and son who have managed to weave together a truly authentic spot to enjoy a taste of Greek cuisine and meet old and new friends. For those of you who have not experienced their traditional mouth-watering meze boards, and delicate pastries, Café Nion offers you a very different culinary understanding. Why not try some deep fried crumbed haloumi cheese and squeeze a little fresh lemon over it before you eat it, which is

traditionally Greek – uuuuummmm a tantalizing epicurean experience indeed!

Don't forget summer is around the corner, and you can expect to see a slight change in their menu. Be sure to sample a frappe, a foam covered iced coffee drink made from instant coffee and drink it like the Greeks do – over a leisurely period of even a couple hours with a friends. Come in and find out what their freddo expresso is all about.

For those brave enough, grab a traditional Greek coffee with a kourabiede which will inject you with plenty of energy to start your day!

What is the GOD Particle?

Learn about the Large Hadron Collider and how it is shaping the future of experimental science.

If you were to dig a hole 300 feet straight down from the center of the charming French village of Crozet, you'd pop into a setting that calls to mind the subterranean lair of one of those James Bond villains. A garishly lit tunnel ten feet in diameter curves away into the distance, interrupted every few miles by lofty chambers crammed with heavy steel structures, cables, pipes, wires, magnets, tubes, shafts, catwalks, and enigmatic gizmos.

This technological netherworld is one very big scientific instrument, specifically, a particle accelerator - an atomic peashooter more powerful than any ever built. It's called the Large Hadron Collider (LHC), and its purpose is simple but ambitious: to crack the code of the physical world; to figure out what the universe is made of; in other words, to get to the very bottom of things.

Inside the LHC, two beams of particles will race in opposite directions around the tunnel, which forms an underground ring 17 miles in circumference. The particles will be guided by more than a thousand

cylindrical, supercooled magnets, linked like sausages. At four locations the beams will converge, sending the particles crashing into each other at nearly the speed of light. If all goes right, matter will be transformed by the violent collisions into wads of energy, which will in turn condense back into various intriguing types of particles, some of them never seen before.

That's the essence of experimental particle physics: You smash stuff together and see what other stuff comes out.

Those masses of equipment spaced along the tunnel will scrutinize the spray from the collisions. The largest, ATLAS, has a detector that's seven stories tall. The heaviest, CMS (for Compact Muon Solenoid), is heavier than the Eiffel Tower. "Bigger is better if you're searching for smaller" could be the motto at the European Organization for Nuclear Research, better known by its historic acronym CERN, the international laboratory that houses the Large Hadron Collider. It sounds scary, and it is. Building the LHC in a tunnel

was a prudent move. The particle beam could drill a hole in just about anything, although the most likely victim would be the apparatus itself. One minor calamity has already happened: A magnet all but jumped out of its skin during a test in March 2007. Since then 24 magnets have been retrofitted to fix a design flaw. The people running the LHC aren't in a rush to talk about all the things that can go wrong, perhaps because the public has a way of worrying that mad scientists will accidentally create a black hole that devours the Earth.

The more plausible fear is that the collider will fail to find the things that physicists insist must be lurking in the deep substrate of reality. Such a big machine needs to produce big science, big answers, something that can generate a headline as well as interesting particles. But even an endeavor of this scale isn't going to answer all the important questions of matter and energy. Not a chance. This is because a century of particle physics has given us a fundamental truth: Reality doesn't reveal its secrets easily.

best to go for a Full HD set if you can as that means you'll also get the best out of Blu-ray films. A new breed of TV is now available to buy with 4K, or Ultra HD (UHD), resolution. 4K TVs have four times the pixels of Full HD models, and so can display even more detailed and vibrant pictures. There's not much 4K content to watch, but a good 4K TV should enhance your regular viewing, too. Consider going 4K if you're upgrading, with good 4K TVs now available at TV Sales & Home.



Are curved screens worth the money?

In the last few years, televisions with concave curved screens have started to emerge - firstly on high-end premium TVs but gradually filtering down to more affordable models. Manufacturers claim that curved TVs can enhance your viewing experience by 'wrapping' the picture around you, a bit like watching a film at the IMAX cinema. However, our expert and independent testing has indicated that the curved effect is minimal at best, and is only really visible if you sit dead straight on while watching the screen (something most people rarely do). Curved TVs still can perform well in our lab overall, but think carefully before buying if one is right for you. Bear in mind, too, that if you want to wall mount your TV, a curved model won't sit as flush as a flatscreen will. Plus, a curved screen can look a bit odd, or even warped, when viewed on an angle. ■

How to Choose a new TV with TV Sales & Home

What size TV should I buy?

With the TV market continually shifting towards larger screens, it's now hard to get a top quality set smaller than 40-inches in size. If space is tight, a huge TV simply might not fit where you want to place it.

How much will I need to spend?

TV prices can start at under \$300, but go into the many thousands for huge screen models. The good news is that you can now get a great TV regardless of your budget.

How do I choose the best TV brand?

There are loads of TV brands all vying for your attention and money.

However, the majority of people will buy a TV from one of the 'big four' TV makers - Samsung, LG, Sony and Panasonic. Samsung is the market leader in TVs, followed closely by South Korean rival LG, and both have huge ranges going from cheap TVs to super-premium, big screen sets costing thousands of dollars. Sony and Panasonic have comparatively smaller ranges, but still have plenty to offer in terms of quality. Aside these four TV giants, there are various fringe brands, such as Toshiba, Sharp and Philips, who have all seen their fortunes rather fade in recent years. Finally, a big chunk of the market is taken up by cheap TVs from the supermarkets and own brands, such as ZLG. These TVs generally have low price tags, but usually lack quality when we test them.

Should I go for HD or 4K?

High definition TVs have been around for a while now and they come in two flavours. HD-Ready TVs are cheaper than ones marked Full HD, or HD Ready 1080p. Both can handle broadcast HD television, but it's

Most entrepreneurs have an 'aha moment' when and what was yours?

"My 'aha!' moment was when somebody told me it would be difficult for somebody like me to start a business especially in Africa, and in Zimbabwe. Right there and then I knew I had to do it... because I am an artist I spent my life being told I was dumb and I can't do it but I knew deep down that God didn't make a fool..."

As a female entrepreneur what would you say have been the barriers or obstacles that you've experienced and overcome?

"...Just recognising that I can do it and being really sad that there are other women whom you want to accept what you do, and they don't. Recognizing that it's okay and that not every woman is going to love and enjoy what you do - you know?! ...As women we just want to be accepted by other women, we want that sister hood and when you don't get that sister hood it tends to be a little bit more difficult because that's where you really find your support system and strengths.

How would you say Vault Cosmetics identifies with the modern day African woman?

"This product identifies with an African woman because I am an African woman who decided to make a product for African women...right there, it's me and what more would one require to identify with something that you can visually see and visually identify with. My troubles are every African woman's troubles and all we want is to be recognised and seen."

You've made many strides since Vault's inception, could you let us in on what your clients will have the benefit of experiencing next?

"...There's just so much excitement and so many things that are definitely happening and one of the things we are looking forward to...Right now the Black American woman is identifying with the black African woman and that's beautiful because that is making our brand grow so amazingly... I am currently working together with Investors and very soon we will be able to launch new products that are not useless, new products that are all useful! The most important aspect is the educational part as this is what I do in terms of a career and it is a privilege to be able to pass this on to other individuals

As a successful Zimbabwean business woman and public figure do you ever feel pressured to participate or be vocal about current affairs, if so how do you draw that line?

"I believe that actions speak louder than words, of course I would like to vocalise on everything but I'd never win because there's always going to be people that agree or disagree with me. The best thing that I can do is make a difference in my country and I am making a difference in my country, I am investing in my country...there's no use in me vocalising issues and not throwing them into action...I am here in LA and I could easily live there, and enjoy a very comfortable life but I choose to be among the struggle and to help my people....I invest in my country and this is how I am vocal in current affairs..." ■

Additional tests may be carried out depending on your presenting complaints and the practitioner's findings. At the end of a consultation an Optometrist will provide you with a prescription for spectacles or medication. If need be they will refer you to an Ophthalmologist for further care.

An Ophthalmologist is a surgeon who specialises in eye care. They are eye care specialists usually seen by referral either from your General Practitioner or Optometrist. However, should you have an emergency you can walk-into their clinics. They attend to the more complex eye conditions which often require long term medical care and/or surgical intervention.

An optician is a health professional who is trained to supply, prepare, and dispense

optical appliances through interpretation of written prescriptions, after consultation either by an Optometrist or Ophthalmologist. An optician fits and finishes eyeglass lenses and frames and may also dispense low vision contact lenses, and artificial eyes after taking account of each patient's visual, lifestyle and vocational needs.

Many of these people thought that they had made adequate provision for retirement only to discover that their savings were worthless when the Zimbabwe dollar collapsed and the country adopted a multi- currency economy.

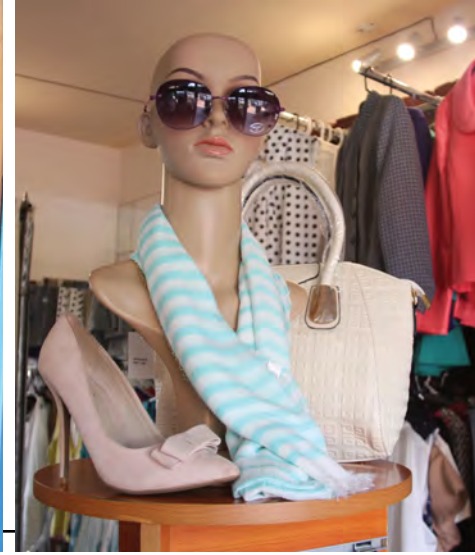
Pensioners' Aid is different from other charities in that it does not provide bulk aid but assists individuals according to their needs. Aid is provided in various forms. It might be assistance with medical expenses, frail care fees, retirement home fees, or simply help with living expenses. The charity also works closely with medical practitioners many of whom provide their services freely or at reduced rates.

The charity has a dedicated, professional team who interview and assess each individual who seeks assistance. Those who qualify are given a very personal and discreet service. Beneficiaries are often encouraged and supported in their own homes or nursing homes. The charity has not only saved the lives of countless pensioners but also helped to put dignity back into their lives. The charity supports between 600 and 700 pensioners at any one time but because funds are limited, there is a waiting list of those seeking help. The demand for the services of the charity continues to rise as the economic situation in the country deteriorates.

Whilst much of the funding for this worthwhile cause comes from overseas this has declined over the years and therefore local fundraising has become more necessary in order to meet demand. To this end the Pensioners' Aid charity shop was opened to raise money.

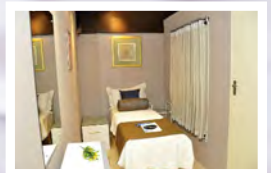

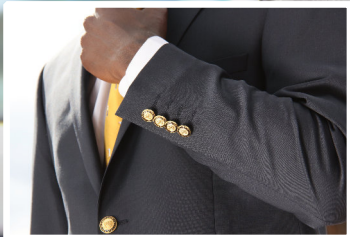
